Information about a competition for research projects carried out at the Center for Theoretical Physics PAS in a year of 2020 by the young scientists under the guidance of research supervisors.

In accordance to “*Regulations of competitions for scientific projects carried out by young scientists under the supervision of scientific supervisors at the Center for Theoretical Physics of the Polish Academy of Sciences*”, hereinafter referred to as the Regulations, I am to announce an internal competition for research projects carried out by young scientists working in the CTP PAS under the direction of their research supervisors. Scientists currently employed in the CTP PAS, who by 24th February 2020:

1. will not have a doctoral degree, or
2. will have a doctoral degree obtained not earlier than 7 years before that date,

are eligible to participate. Written submissions to the competition no longer than three A4 pages should be submitted to the secretary office of CTP PAS by **24th February 2020**. The application should contain the following information: a summary of management, including the name of the research, the purpose of the study, a description of the proposed work and a description of the intended use of the results, as well as a detailed description of the proposed research with justification. Applications are submitted jointly by the young scientist and a scientific supervisor of the project.

According to the Regulations, the commission for young staff matters will award prizes to the authors of the best projects for the financing of their research. In the year 2020, we will award prizes for a total amount of thirty thousand zloty.

The evaluation of the proposals will take place by 28th February 2020. The results of the competition will be announced by a Committee Chairman for the young staff in a written form. The Commission for the young staff will post a message about the results of the competition on a website of the CTP PAS .
